Eggs, sugar, butter

STEP 1: Knowing *what to* (1))
with the cake ingredients

Put eggs, sugar, and butter in the bowl.
Mix them together. Pour into the cake pan.

Put the cake in the oven. Bake it.
Then, cut it into two parts.



STEP 2: Knowing *when to* (2)) ginger with the cream

Make the cream. Cut the ginger in small pieces. Mix the ginger and the cream.
Then, put it in the cake.

STEP 3: Knowing *how to* (3)) and (4)) the chocolate

Cut the chocolate into small pieces. Add butter. Melt it with the hot cream. Pour
the chocolate on the cake.


