Example: The rabbit is faster than the turtle. (The rabbit > the turtle.)

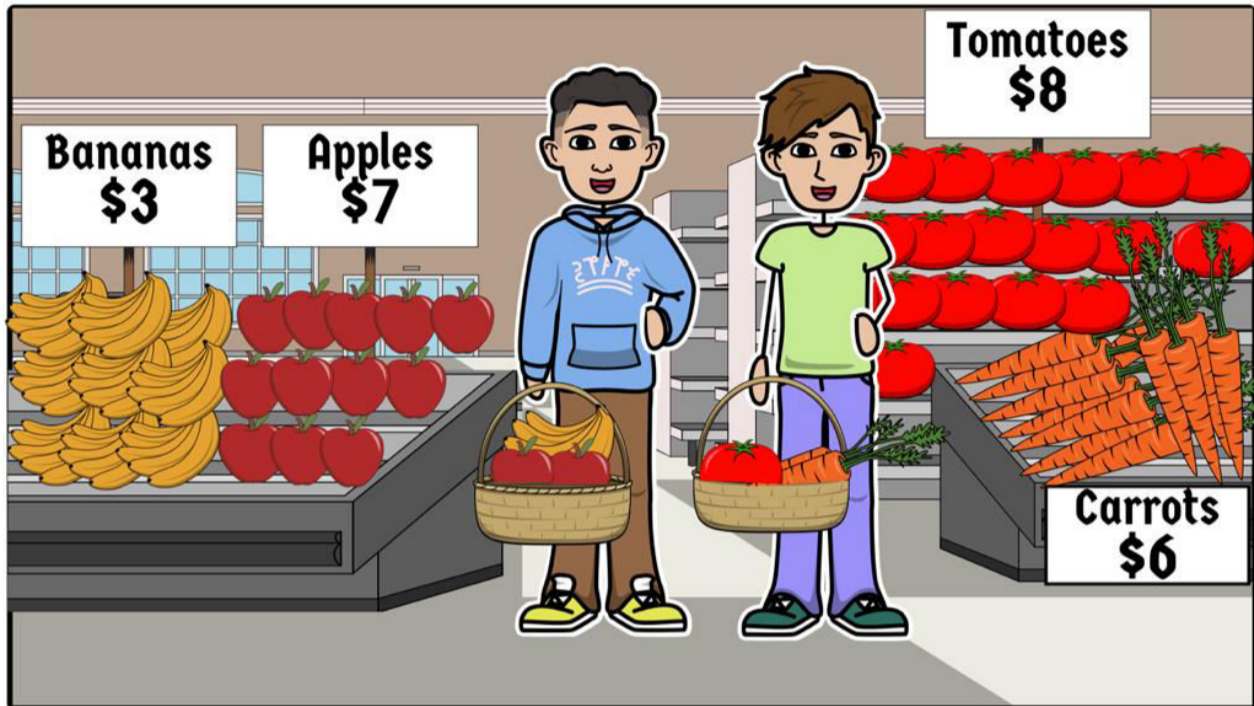
